

Student Leadership Covenant

Welcome to a new and exciting year as a part of our Student Leadership in WSM. My prayer is you would be blessed through our time together, as well strengthened in your walk with Christ. As we begin this new year I am asking you to make a yearlong commitment to this ministry, because with great power comes great responsibility (Spiderman). I am partly joking with the great power aspect, but not with the great responsibility aspect of this ministry. With this role there is more expected of you than anyone else in this ministry. I will be spending more time with you than any other students in your ministry. You will have a stronger voice in the decisions of our ministry, as well as leading and mentoring students younger than you, helping to equip them in ministry. So as we begin the year I want to lay out my expectation for you and your parents. This covenant must be signed by both you and your parents and turned in prior to our next meeting.

Expectations:

1. Strive daily to grow in your walk with Christ. John 15:5 tells us apart from Christ our ministry is useless. You can do lots of good in this world and never bear fruit in ministry. This is our main goal in ministry, above everything else.
2. Write a 500 word essay (300 words for 7th & 8th graders) answering two questions. What is leadership? Who am I leading? This should be typed, proof read and handed into me at our November meeting.
3. Attend at our meetings. We will have one meeting each month and it is absolutely necessary that you are at every meeting. I understand things will come up where you have no control but those are few and far between. You are expected to be here when we do get together. We will meet on the second Sunday afternoon of each month. Typically, we will go eat lunch and go back to the building for an hour. We will from time to time have very brief meetings just to get input but these will almost always coincide with other events.
4. Participate in Bible Class and Revolution on a weekly basis. "I am tired" is not a valid excuse. You need to be in classes at least 80% of the time. It is impossible for you to make an impact on something you are never there for.
5. You must be involved in at least one other ministry and have a leadership role within that ministry throughout the year.
